REMEMBER GUN SAFETY

SCRATCHES: Scratches at the discretion of Pin Oak HRC and the Hunt Committee. For refunds, scratches require veterinarian's certification of serious injury or bitch in season.

GUN SAFETY: All seasoned and finished dog handlers MUST handle and shoot shotgun (primer shells). A handler (and his/her dog) demonstrating poor gun safety while handling the shotgun during an HRC hunt test can and will be disqualified.

LUNCH: Lunch and beverage available both days at a cost of \$7.00. Please bring your own drinks for other than lunch.

RAFFLE: Raffle tickets will be sold on Saturday for a raffle of prizes on Saturday night.
